1. Demonstrate the size of the problem

Just stating the statistics is insufficient

2. Refer to an evidenced based source document and action plan

3. Demonstrate gaps and inequalities in occurrence of stroke and in stroke services

4. Show that substantial improvements can be made

5. Demonstrate that actions are extremely cost effective for the society

6. Measure progress: surveillance and quality of care

The chain of arguments needs to be used on all levels



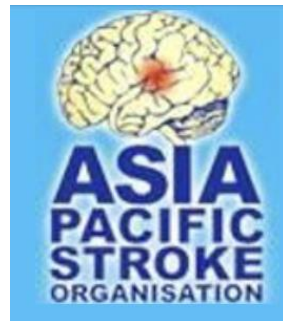
