



Dear Stroke Action Plan - ESO

The Danish Stroke Association is pleased to announce that the Danish Minister of Health recently presented on national TV that a stroke action plan will be part of the governments political agenda for the coming years.

To quote the Minister the overarching goal will be to “minimize the number of strokes by 10% by 2030”. Furthermore, the minister underlined the governments wish to strengthen stroke prevention, emergency-treatment and using data to optimize quality and research.

We have received a letter from the Minister of Health, where he invites The Danish Stroke Association to negotiations. On the same occasion, the minister will formally sign the European declaration.

A significant prerequisite for the fact that we have now come this far in Denmark, is that we have worked with a Danish implementation where we were able to build on the great preparatory work that has been carried out in SAP-E.

The political tailwind we are experiencing and the decisive step the Danish government took yesterday can hopefully serve as both leverage and inspiration for the work in the rest of Europe.
