

Stroke achievements of Northern Ireland in 2023

The most important achievement of year 2023

Further development of a cohesive stroke network agreeing regional standards of care and delivering service improvement across the stroke pathway

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Advance in acute stroke care

- Delivering thrombectomy to 5.8 % of ischaemic strokes whilst improving equity of access, particularly to those furthest from the thrombectomy centre, through a region wide thrombectomy forum
- Advance in secondary prevention
- Development of a regional pathway for TIA service provision
 Advance in rehabilitation
- Agreement on a regional approach to spasticity management Advance in life after stroke
- Standardised regional service model for Long Term Support

Stroke achievements of Spain in 2023

Update of the National Strategic Stroke Plan in October 2023 (previous plan launched in 2009) including participation of representatives of Ministry of Health and Neurology Spanish Society, responsible from Regional Stroke Plans across nation, stroke experts and three Stroke Support Organizations).

The updated Stroke Plan includes **6 strategic areas** revising state of the art and proposal of objectives and recommendations:

- > 1. Health Promotion and Primary Prevention
- ➤ 2. Secondary prevention
- ➤ 3. Hyperacute phase. Care organization and treatment
- ➤ 4. Stroke Units
- ➤ 5. Rehabilitation and life after stroke
- ➢ 6. Research and Training

Stroke achievements of Armenia in 2023

The most important achievement of year 2023

- ≻Two new stroke centers; national stroke database
- Advance in acute stroke care
- ➤One new comprehensive stroke center in Yerevan, one stroke ready hospital using tele stroke in Lori region, Armenia

- Extensive collaboration with MOH and preparation of governmentally sponsored stroke prevention program (pilot phase): will be launched in coming months


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The most important achievement of year 2023

- Advance in acute stroke care
- Updated stroke EMS protocol
- Advance in secondary prevention
- Introduction of the electronic patient record (although at the moment it does not cover all the information necessary for tracking stroke)
- Advance in life after stroke
- > Established the first peer-to-peer stroke support group in Bankya, Sofia

Stroke achievements of Catalonia in 2023

- The most important achievement of year 2023
- Renewal of the Stroke Strategy for Catalonia 2023 2025
- Advances in acute stroke care
- > Addition of 2 other Thrombectomy capable, ESO-certified, hospitals
- Advance in secondary prevention
- > No specific advances
- Advance in rehabilitation
- > Publication of the Rehabilitation Plan for Catalonia. Stroke is a priority:
 - Assessment of rehab needs and initiation of rehab treatment 23-48 h after onset
 - Sets criteria for intensity, inpatient/outpatient
- Map of Rehab resources & professionals, design of a Stroke-related Disability Registry
- Advance in life after stroke Scaling-up of the **ABRIC** Programme
 - Stroke Foundation of Catalonia, ABRIC = coat \rightarrow protection, comfort, support
 - Telephone-based, no cost, > 1000 active patients

- Plan for establishing network of out-patients stroke neurologist submitted to MoH, education programme and Certification of Stroke neurologists started
- Advance in rehabilitation
- Start of compulsory quality monitoring in rehabilitation, obtaining the data about all rehabilitated pts, MoH funding programme for neurorehabilitation

Stroke achievements of Denmark in 2023

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The most important achievement of year 2023

Implementation of measuring functional outcome 3 months (modified Rankin Scale) after stroke on a national level

Advance in acute stroke care

~23 % of patients with ischemic stroke receives reperfusion therapy (IVT 19%, MT 6%)

Advance in secondary prevention

In 94 % of patients with stroke and AFIB (without contraindications) oral anticoagulation is initiated within 14 days and after one year 91 % of the patients is still on oral anticoagulation

Advance in rehabilitation

~ 82 % of patients receives rehabilitation with physiotherapist and/or occupational therapist within 5 days

Despite major challenges (reorganisation of the health care system, severe nurse shortage) stroke care has been kept in high level

Stroke achievements of Georgia in 2023

- STROKE ACTION PLAN EUROPE 2018 - 2030
- > Increased number of EVT capable stroke centres (6 in total, 4 in Tbilisi, 2 in regions)
- Increased number of IVT and EVT
- Decree of the Minster of Health of Georgia by April 21, 2023 on Establishing Stroke Care System in the Country
- Joint efforts of the Georgian Stroke Association, hospitals and MoH of Georgia
- Criteria for primary stroke units and comprehensive stroke centers
- Protocol for EMS (detailed pathway including drip-and-ship and mothership models)
- Task force established for certifications of primary stroke units and stroke centers
- Need for setting up national quality registry by 2024 emphasized
- Increased use of DOACs and statins when appropriate
- Reimbursement by state of short term (2 weeks) post-stroke rehab courses

Stroke achievements of Ireland in 2023



- Acute > Thrombectomy at 9% of ischaemic stroke (IS) population
 - ➤ Mortality for IS at historic low at 7.5% (INAS 2022)
 - Rate of swallow screening improved to 71% (from 68%) and national QI commenced with a target of 100% of swallow screens completed.
 - > Public awareness campaign launched to improve patient attendance times
 - Safe nurse staffing levels established in acute stroke units and a nationally agreed core competencies for stroke nurse training . Curriculum submitted for national sign off.
- S.Prev. > Over 300k euro made available to 15 stroke centres to buy atrial fibrillation and blood pressure monitoring equipment
 - > GP contract changed to include detection and management of grade 1 hypertension in all adults
 - ➢ Pathway of care for Atrial Fibrillation agreed
 - RHB ➤ Early Supported Discharge (ESD) now commissioned across 11 of our 22 acute stroke centres and 10% patients go home with ESD.
- Life after stroke > 979 referrals made to Irish Heart Foundation "Stroke Connect" in 2023, 78% from acute Hospitals. Target reached of 1 in 4 referrals.

Education > Clinical Advisory Group "Education and Training" committee was established.

➢ National Clinical Guidelines for UK and Ireland published and endorsed by RCPI

Stroke achievements of Israel in 2023

- The most important achievement of year 2023

Stable rate of IVT with a slight rise in MT over the last 3 years - IVT 25%, MT 10-11%
Advance in secondary prevention

- in the most of the hospitals we achieved 85% in OACs, and > 85% in antiplatelets
 Advance in rehabilitation
- In big, we analysed data about neurorehabilitation and discussed them with Ministry of health, some new neurorehabilitation centers in stroke hospitals

Advance in life after stroke

we have no obvious progress, somewhere cognitive functions are being monitored and speech training is being done

Stroke achievements of Sweden in 2023

- The most important achievement of year 2023
- Continual increase in reperfusion rates and a new TBY center established
- Advance in acute stroke care
- >19% of all ischemic stroke treated with reperfusion, 9 % with thrombectomy
- Advance in secondary prevention
- Very high proportions of ischemic stroke patients with AF treated with anticoagulants (ceiling approaching)
- Advance in rehabilitation
- >Half of all hospitals reach target for early supported discharge
- Advance in life after stroke
- Structured follow up including post-stroke checklist increasingly used

Stroke achievements of Ukraine in 2023

The most important achievement of year 2023

Stroke is still considered as a priority for the MoH and NHS despite the war

Advance in acute stroke care

- New order of the MoH with the definition of 3 types of hospital (basic, basic+neurosurgery, basic+endovascular) and prehospital triage based on scales
- ➤tPA rate is close to 10% (10 527 cases)
- ➤MT rate is about 1,5%
- New Angiographs with specific neuro package are bought (2 biplane, 14 monoplanes). No region left in Ukraine without the possibility of MT

Advance in rehabilitation

➢New rules and tariffs for the inpatient rehab for the 2024 (upto 8 cycles 14 days each – each cycle costs 31000 UAH (about 750 EUR) and only when proper number of rehab personnel is present in hospital)
